Franchot to Visit Randallstown Businesses and Volunteer Fire Company Today

Liberty Road VFC celebrating its 75th year

WHO: Comptroller Peter Franchot

WHAT: Comptroller Franchot will make three stops in Randallstown this afternoon, beginning with [The Crab Queen](#), a new seafood carryout born out of the COVID-19 pandemic. Owner Felicia Covell Rami saw business from her popular catering company, [Xquisite Catering](#), dry up when all in-person events were canceled. She started selling seafood boils and other weekly specials out of her catering kitchen. The customer response was overwhelming, which led her to open The Crab Queen in April 2021.

Next, the Comptroller will visit [ComForCare](#), a business that provides a variety of non-medical home care services to individuals in Baltimore City, and Baltimore and Carroll counties. Staff assist with meal preparation, light housekeeping, transportation, medication reminders and even just companionship, which helps clients stay in their own homes longer and do the things they enjoy. Franchise owner Jenette Young spent nearly 30 years in the retail food industry before applying those skills to home care in 2009.

Mr. Franchot will then swing by [Liberty Road Volunteer Fire Company](#) to pay tribute to the courageous men and women who save lives and protect property every day. He will present a proclamation honoring the station's 75 years of service to the Randallstown community and surrounding areas and learn about the Company's use of a \$300,000 Capital Grant Loan approved by the Board of Public Works in December 2020.
