Franchot to Attend Easton's First Chesapeake Fire and Ice Festival

Saturday visit also includes stopping by Stews & Brews

WHO: Comptroller Peter Franchot

WHAT: Comptroller Peter Franchot will stop by two venues Saturday afternoon at Easton's inaugural Chesapeake Fire and Ice Festival, which runs from February 14 to 16. The festival will feature free live music, fire performances, outdoor ice skating, the unveiling of 41 ice sculptures including a self-guided tour and light display. There also will be family-friendly events, entertainment, shopping and restaurant specials. Ice Labs, a nationally-renowned, Baltimore-based ice art company, will create all the sculptures.

After Mr. Franchot takes in the ice sculpture carvings at Thompson Park, he then will head over to the Easton Volunteer Firehouse to join local residents in sampling stews made by local chefs and sipping a variety of local craft beers.
