## Comptroller Lierman to Give Keynote Address to Women of MACo at Annual Summer Conference in Ocean City

*Speech to focus on the impact of women in leadership and the importance of women to the economy*

**ANNAPOLIS, Md. (August 14, 2024)** — Comptroller Brooke E. Lierman will deliver the keynote address at the Women of MACo Luncheon on Friday, August 16, 2024, during the annual Maryland Association of Counties (MACo) summer conference in Ocean City.

Earlier this year, Comptroller Lierman released the agency's first State of the Economy, which showed Maryland's Labor Participation Rate had dropped four percentage points between 2019 and 2023 and had not recovered to its pre-pandemic high. The report also revealed that women were among the individuals who had not rejoined the labor force, in large part, because of caregiving responsibilities and access to childcare.

In addition to Comptroller Lierman's keynote during the Women of MACo Luncheon, Chief Information Officer Robert O'Connor will share his expertise during the session entitled "Effective Remediation Strategies for Addressing Cybersecurity Issues: A Practical Guide for State, County and Local Agencies". Director of Intergovernmental Affairs Michael Bayrd will also speak during the panel, "New Money, New Strings: Taming Target Funds." The Office of the Comptroller will also have a booth inside the Exhibit Hall of the Roland Powell Convention Center, which will feature information and resources connected to the agency and its work.

The summer conference, which runs from August 14 to 17, convenes thousands of leaders from all levels of government and the private sector and provides an opportunity for connection and to engage in thought leadership on a range of topics impacting local government in Maryland.
